
## Important: "Starter Technical Bulletin"





We at Powermaster have found that you can't always depend on choosing a Small Block Ford starter by application only. Most automatic and 5-speed manual transmissions use the m/t starter. Some 4-speed manual transmissions use the m/t starter and some use the a/t starter. Also, when mixing and matching engines, transmission and bell housings, they will vary. It's critical to <u>ALWAYS MEASURE the DEPTH or OFFSET</u>. Refer to the illustration, measure from the engine side of the ring gear to the starter mounting surface on the mid plate. It should measure 3/4" or 3/8". Determine the starter you need in the column beside the depth gauge. Be sure that you are choosing the correct starter for your performance needs. A high compression engine needs a higher torque starter than an OE stock engine. (Refer to Starter App Guide) In some cases you may have a measurement different than 3/4 or 3/8.
