
Thank you for choosing Race Ramps' Portable Pit Stop Ramp

- Check that the ramps have not become damaged during loading or shipping.

- USE CNLY on a level, relatively even surface. Remove all small hard objects such as pebbles or stone, as they can set like I bearings and they ARE NOT an optimal surface for the PPS to used on. Out and sond are acceptable.
- CENTER VEHICLE LOAD on the middle of the ramps. Drive up the ramps with both time centered on the ramps.

- PLACE RAMPS STRAIGHT in line with the front and rear fires. As you drive up the ramps you MUST stay in center of them, WHERS POINTED STRAIGHT ANEADS
- USE ALL RECES described in the manual. DO NOT attempt to use these ramps in any other way than what is described in this manual.

The Partable Pit Stop Ramp comes in two different models; the Racer model, and the Standard model. The Racer model contains a 2.5" cutout for using a standard 15x15x2.5" scale in. It day fortuses a partar for Ellion the poor, cented

in ass recovers a speciar for timing the gap created when a scale is not in use. The Standard model does not have these features. This guide is applicable to both models; if you have the Standard model, skip the steps regarding the scale cutouts and spaces.



The Portable Pit Stop Ramp system is a lightweight, convenient way to get your vehicle up in the air. It can be used on most surfaces, including sand, dirt. capinals, concrete etc.

The Partable Pit Stop Ramp is adjustable for wheelbase lengths of 98-110". Once you have driven up the PPS, you can place the ramps on the front so you can drive down it. You can also remove various sections of the ramp once the car is fully in place on top of the PPS platform.





The PPS is also designed so it can be stored in a tight, convenient space when it is not in use.

Preparation and Assembly

First, examine all the parts that came shipped with the PPS. Refer to the below diagram to make sure you have all the pieces.

Take a few minutes to clear your workspace of small debris or particles, such as pubbles or stones. Place piece 5 and 6 where you want your front tire to be. From there, place piece 4, 3, 2, and 1 all in order. Make sure each piece properly interlocks.



Measure the distance between the front and rear fires (wheelbase), and the distance between the left and right tries (width) of your vehicle.

Now assemble the apposite side of the PPS. Use your vehicles width measurement to place the PPS **xemetric**.

Assembly Cont

Place piece 2 so that your rear tire will be centered. If your vehicle has a wheelbose length longer than 98°, you will notice a gap will be created. Fill this gap in with the spacers (pieces 7, 8, and 9), like shown. Use as many spacers as required for your wheelbose length; it's a k to have up to 0.5° of space between sech spaces.

Now your PPS is fully assembled. Make sure that your car will not



A spotter is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for driving up the PPS safely. Drive up the PPS at a slow, consistent speed.



If you need to use a jack or other lifting devices, DO NOT place directly on PPSI Only use Jack plates for lifting. The Jack plates are marked by "The Bast Way To Clerk to Un" strike. DO NOT place Jack plates on the sloped

"The Best Way To Get III Up" sticker. DO NOT place Jack plotes on the sloped part of the ramp. Make sure Jack plate is placed evenly, and not overlapping the edges. One of the wheelbase spacers, piece 9, can also function as a Jack Plate; make sure "The Best Way To Get II Up" sticker is facting up!.





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
