

RUBBER ISOLATOR REMOVAL DIAGRAM This technique can be used if and Exhaust Hanger Removal Pliers is not available. Using a 5/8" open end wrench, slide the wrench up to the rubber isolator, cradling the hanger rod as shown. Next place the flat edge of a pry bar between the wrench and the hanger stop or hanger rod. Then simply rotate the pry bar toward the wrench to remove the rubber isolator. Note: Using a spray lubricant or soapy water on the hanger rod and the rubber

isolator helps removal.

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
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

INSTALLATION STEPS

- Lower exhaust for ease of installation by removing six (6) rubber isolators. (See RUBBER ISOLATOR REMOVAL DIAGRAM.)
- 2. Raise DRIVER SIDE PLATE and PASSENGER SIDE PLATE over existing studs on vehicle bumper beam, as shown.
- 3. Loosely install M12-1.50 hex flange nuts to secure side plates to vehicle, as shown.
- 4. Raise CENTER SECTION into position between side plates.
- 5. Loosely install 3/8 in. carriage bolts and hex flange nuts through CENTER SECTION and side plates, as shown.
- 6. Fishwire 1/2 in. carriage bolts and CM-SP40 spacers through vehicle crossmember access hole and out hexagonal mouting holes in bottom of crossmember. (See FISHWIRE TECHNIQUE diagram.)
- 7. Raise MOUNTING STRAP SECTION into position.
- 8. Loosely install 7/16 in. carriage bolts and hex flange nuts through MOUNTING STRAP SECTION and CENTER SECTION, as shown.
- 9. Loosely install 1/2 in. hex flange nuts onto carriage bolts from Step 6 to secure MOUNTING STRAP SECTION to vehicle crossmember.
- 10. Torque 1/2 in. hardware to 110 lb-ft, 7/16 in. hardware to 70 lb-ft, 3/8 in hardware to 45 lb-ft, and M12-1.50 hardware to 82 lb-ft.
- 11. Raise exhaust back into position.

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
