

## 2006-13 C6 Corvette Z06 RACE 3" X-Pipe to OEM Muffler 70801308-RHKR – X-Pipe w/o Cats Installation Instructions



Thank you for making HOOKER HEADERS your choice in a high-performance exhaust system. Extensive dyno/track testing has enabled HOOKER to offer the most advanced design in exhaust systems. The installation, while not complex, will take a certain amount of time. However, the additional horsepower and improved performance will more than justify your efforts. Proper installation and maintenance will ensure long life and maximum performance from your HOOKER BLACKHEART exhaust system.

## **BEFORE STARTING:**

Your vehicle must be raised a minimum of 18 inches. A floor hoist is ideal. If no hoist is available, we strongly urge the use of axle stands as a safety measure. Please read and understand these instructions and disclaimer in their entirety before attempting installation.

# CAUTION! WORK ONLY ON A LEVEL SURFACE. USE JACKS /JACK STANDS OF SUFFICIENT CAPACITY TO LIFT AND SUPPORT YOUR VEHICLE. NEVER WORK UNDER A VEHICLE SUPPORTED BY A FLOOR OR BUMPER JACK.

## **INSTALLATION:**

NOTE: Your Hooker Blackheart Race exhaust system is designed to be used with Hooker Blackheart Headers P/N 70101317-RHKR or 70101323-RHKR and is not designed to be used with the factory manifolds or catalytic converters.

#### IMPORTANT: Inspect your accessory pack: BEFORE YOU START!

- 1. Place the vehicle on flat a surface, set the parking brake, and block the front wheels.
- 2. Disconnect the negative terminal of the battery.
- 3. Lift the vehicle and support with jack stands.

#### WARNING! Never support a vehicle with a floor or bumper jack.

## **REMOVING THE OEM EXHAUST:**

1. Loosen the clamps at the end of the H-Pipe where it connects to the muffler inlet pipes.

- 2. Remove the (x4) nuts at the H-Pipe where it connects to the catalytic converter down pipes. Remove the (x2) nuts at the center spring hangers. Slide the flanges off of the studs and remove the H-Pipe from the muffler inlet pipes.
- 3. Follow installation instructions for Hooker Blackheart Headers P/N 70101317-RHKR P/N 70101323-RHKR – Z06 ONLY

## INSTALLATION OF YOUR HOOKER BLACKHEART RACE EXHAUST:

- 1. Install (x2) 3" Torca couplers onto each header collector (bolt to the **inside** and the nut facing down).
- 2. Install the left and right link pipes on to the header collectors and tighten the clamps to allow for adjustment.
- 3. Install (x2) 76mm band clamp onto each X-pipe inlet (bolt to the bottom and nut facing the outside of the car).
- 4. Slide the X-pipe on to the link pipes outlet (spring hanger bracket facing up) and install the spring hanger and nuts.
- 5. Install (x2) 3" Torca couplers at the X-pipe outlet, bolts to the inside and nuts facing down.
- 6. Tighten the clamps on the X-pipe where it connects to the link pipes to allow for adjustment.
- 7. Connect the over-axle pipes from the OEM muffler to the X-Pipe and tighten the couplers to allow for adjustment.
- 8. Tighten the clamps on the X-pipe where it connects to the link pipes to allow for adjustment.
- 9. Check all of the O2 sensor connections and make sure the harnesses are routed away from the exhaust and secure.
- 10. Check all the hardware and the connection points for proper installation and clearance.
- 11. Adjust all components for proper alignment and tighten all clamps and hardware starting at the front and working towards the tailpipes.
- **NOTE:** For additional ground clearance, tack weld the link pipe to the X-pipe after alignment. Remove the X-pipe, remove the clamps, and weld the slip joint and slots on each pipe. Reinstall the X-pipe.
- 12. Remove the jack stands and lower the car. Connect the battery and remove the wheel blocks.
- 13. Start the vehicle and check for leaks and loose hardware.
- 14. Check all hardware again after the first 150 miles of driving.
- **NOTE:** Your HOOKER Blackheart RACE exhaust has no provisions for the rear (post catalyst) o2 sensors and will result in a check engine light. The use of a tuner is recommended to correct this condition and take full advantage of the performance potential of this exhaust system.
