Features:

- Easily installed on the negative battery post.
- Simply disconnect the battery by unscrewing the knob (counter clockwise) a few turns, and reconnect by tightening the knob (clockwise).
- Knob can be removed to deter thieves.
- Compact in size and fits most battery compartments.
- Works with 12, 16 or 24 volt systems.
- Not Approved or Intended for Marine Use.
- Rated @ 500 amps surge and 125 amps continuous @ 12 volts.
- Can be installed on side post batteries by using a negative terminal post adapter #10322.
- Available with a 15-amp fused bypass #10321 that retains computer settings, radio/clock, etcetera while the battery is disconnected. Note: If you attempt to start the vehicle while the unit is disconnected, it will blow the fuse.
