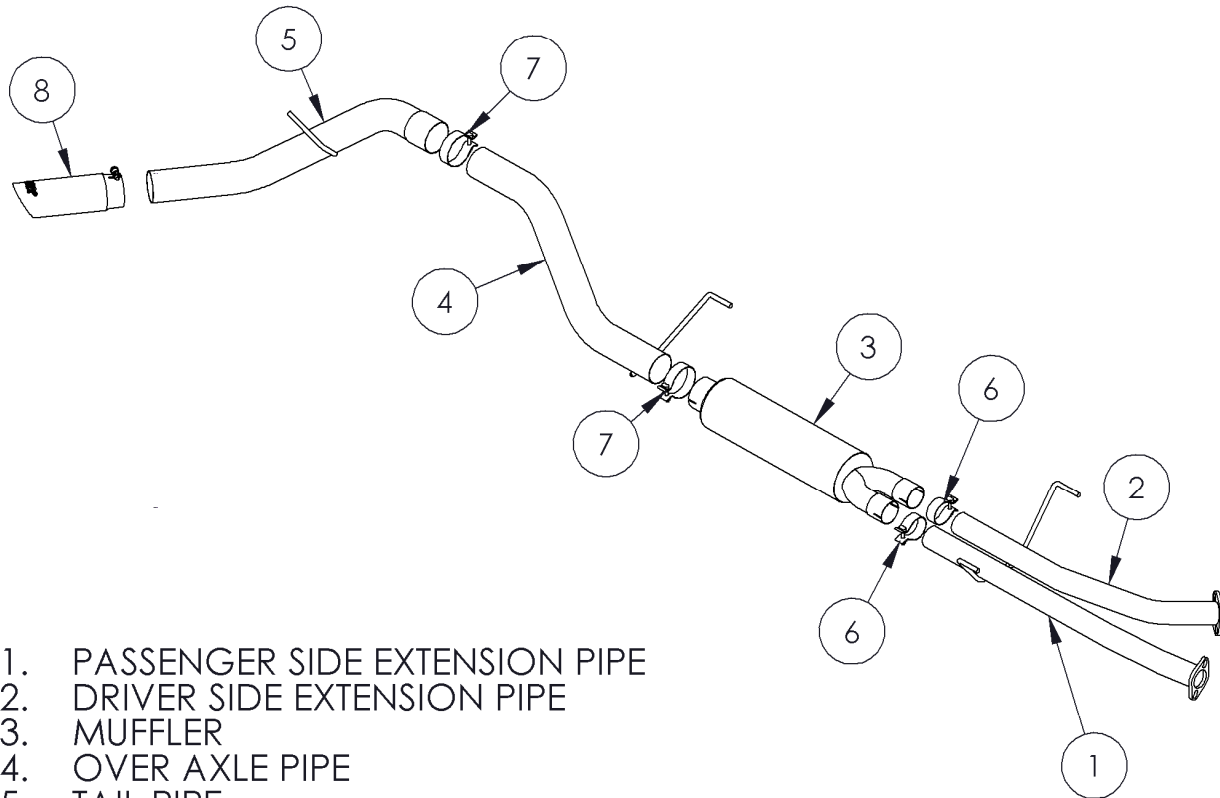

1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.

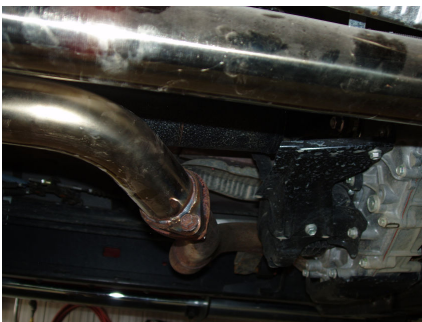

2. Remove hardware from stock extension pipes. Keep for reinstallation. **Refer to Figure 1.**

3. Remove exhaust from rubber insulators. **Refer to Figure 2.**

4. Remove the exhaust from the rearmost hanger. Leave the rubber insulators on the truck for installation. **Refer to Figure 3.**

**Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:**

1. Install **Driver Side Extension Pipe** reusing the existing hardware and attaching the hanger to the existing rubber insulator. Snug the hardware but leave loose enough for some adjustment. **Refer to Figure 4.**



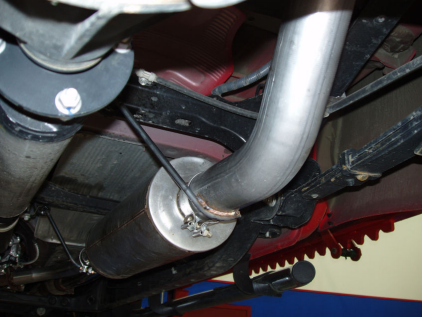

2. Install **Passenger Side Extension Pipe** reusing the existing hardware. Snug the hardware but leave loose enough for some adjustment. **Refer to Figure 5.**

3. Slide the **2.5" Band Clamps** over the **Passenger Side Extension Pipe** and **Driver Side Extension Pipe**. Install **Muffler** onto the two front pipes. **Refer to Figure 6.**

4. Slide a **3.5" Band Clamp** over the outlet side of the **Muffler**. Position the **Over Axle Pipe** and loosely attach it to the **Muffler**. Install the hanger into the existing rubber insulators. **Refer to Figure 7.**

5. Slide a **3.5" Band Clamp** over the **Tail Pipe** and install onto the **Over Axle Pipe**. Slide **Tail Pipe** hanger into the rearmost rubber insulator. **Refer to Figure 8.**

7. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tip** to suit. Using a 17mm wrench tighten the lock bolt located on the **Exhaust Tip**.

8. Align the exhaust as required. Starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections.

9. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire, fuel and brake lines realign if necessary.
