



HOW TO INSTALL A U-BOLT





Direction #903

- Step #1. Slip bar bushing onto the bar.
- Step #2. Assemble end-links as illustrated. Mounting plate is above bar end when dip in bar is pointing down below tail pipe.
- Step #3. Position bar under car with mid-section of the bar pointing forward, arm of the bar to the rear so the eyes are below and just forward of the lower suspension A-arm. Adjust bar so small hole of mounting plate is above A-arm, and the end-link is just clear of the front side of the A-arm. Mark the A-arm, and drill a 3/8" hole after making sure bar is centered on the car.
- Step #4. Bolt on the mounting plate with the bolt and lock-nut provided.
- Step #5. Raise bar mid-section until rubber bushings are against the frame cover bushing with frame bracket, and mark frame for drilling.
- Step #6. Drill 3/8" hole and insert square U-bolt to hold bar bracket as described in general instructions.
- Step #7. Check all fastening for suitable tightness. Nut on end-links should not be so tight as to distort rubber bushing.
