

1. **Disconnect the negative battery cable!** Disconnect the crank case vent line quick disconnect fittings from the intake plenum. Loosen the two hose clamps that secure the intake plenum to the throttle body and to the air filter housing, then remove the intake plenum from the vehicle.



2. On vehicles equipped with a intake plenum support brace secured to the passenger side cylinder head, remove the bolt shown securing the support bracket.

3. On vehicles equipped with the intake plenum support bracket, install the provided spacer between the bracket and cylinder head and secure with the provided hardware.

NOTE: The tap on the support bracket will be inserted into the hole of the spacer when properly installed.



4. Remove the four bolts that secure the throttle body to the intake manifold. Pull the throttle body away from the intake manifold without disconnecting the wiring harness.



5. Install the provided new bolts through the holes in the throttle body, through the holes in the provided gasket and through the POWERAID spacer. Start the new bolts into the inserts in the intake manifold being careful not to cross thread the bolts. Tighten the bolts in a cross pattern to the factory specifications. NOTE: Be sure to install the spacer in the correct direction as noted on the spacer.



6. Reinstall the factory intake plenum, reconnect the crank case vent lines. **Reconnect the negative battery cable!**
