

Tools required:

Jack and jackstands Ratchet 19mm deep well socket 19mm wrench

- 1. Lift vehicle and support with jack stands under the frame rails.
- 2. Starting with one side, using the 19mm socket and wrench, remove the upper control arm bolts and upper control arm.
- 3. If you are using new differential bushings, spray the factory bushings with penetrating oil and drive them out with a hammer or air punch (Some cars may require professional installation for this bushing but most will come out with a little patience). Once the bushings are out, clean and lube the bushing holes and drive the new bushings into place. Grease the outer mounting surfaces of the bushings.
- 4. Using the factory control arms as a guide, set the length of the new control arms to factory length.
- 5. Install the new upper control arm as shown in **IMAGE 1** using the 19mm socket and wrench.
- 6. Ensure jam nuts on adjuster are tightened.
- 7. Repeat steps for the other side.
- 8. Lower vehicle.
