#### **ATTENTION:**

#### **Programming**

- Using a factory approved tool, program the module to the latest software.
- Ensure that the configurations selected matches factory options (RPO codes).

#### **Learn the Restraints ID**

- On vehicles equipped with an SDM, the restraint code must be reprogrammed to match the BCM. Failure to do this will result in a stored DTC and an airbag trouble code light.

#### **Theft Learn**

- On vehicles equipped with anti-theft measures, the keys must be relearned to the vehicle. Failure to relearn the keys will result in the vehicle not starting.

#### **Clear DTCs**

- After programming and setting up the module, clear all DTCs and perform a key cycle before attempting to start the vehicle.
