

EXHAUST INSTALLATION #315552

WHEN INSTALLING THIS SYSTEM, MAKE SURE TO USE PROPER SAFTEY PRECAUTONS. USE JACK STAND WHEN UNDER TRUCK, SET PARKING BRAKE, BLOCK TIRES, AND SAFTEY GLASSES AND GLOVES. **DO NOT WORK WITH HOT PIPES!**

SUGGESTED TOOLS:

15mm SOCKET, 9/16" SOCKET, $\frac{1}{2}$ " WRENCH, $\frac{1}{2}$ " SOCKET, JACK STAND, HACKSAW, WD-40

- Lay out the GIBSON EXHAUST SYSTEM on the floor so it looks like the drawing.
 (Note: Drawing is not exact but for placement of parts only.)
- 2. Raise vehicle and support with stands. Unbolt stock flange behind the rear of the converter. You will reuse stock bolts and gasket.
- 3. Use jack stand to support converter so it won't drop. Remove stock hangers leaving all rubber mounting grommets in place. Cut the stock tailpipe for easy removal.
- 4. Connect head pipe #A to the stock flange behind the converter with stock bolts and stock gasket. Insert welded hanger into rubber grommet.
- 5. Connect muffler with inlet toward the converter to the head pipe. Use jack stand to support the muffler and connect to headpipe with clamp #G. DO NOT TIGHTEN.
 Muffler inlet is looking into the louvers.
- 6. Install the over axle tailpipe #C, and insert hanger into rubber grommet. Connect hanger using #F to over axle tailpipe and muffler.. DO NOT TIGHTEN.
- 7. Connect turnout exit pipe #D to the over axle tail pipe. Roll turnout pipe until you have it at the correct angle for your truck and connect clamp #G.
- 8. Install stainless steel tip. To clean tip use any stainless steel or aluminum cleaner with a scott brite pad.
- 9. When you have everything in place, firmly tighten all bolts and clamp down securely.

MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A 1" CLEARANCE AWAY FROM ALL FUEL & BRAKE LINES, SHOCKS, TIRES, PIPES, ETC.
