*FITS REG. CAB w/ 8' BED, QUAD CAB w/ 6'4" BED, & CREW CAB w/ 5'7" BED (ALL 140.5 - 140.7 WB)



Thank you for making HOOKER HEADERS your choice in a high-performance exhaust system. Extensive dyno/track testing has enabled HOOKER to offer the most advanced design in exhaust systems. The installation, while not complex, will take a certain amount of time. However, the additional horsepower and improved performance will more than justify your efforts. Proper installation and maintenance will ensure long life and maximum performance from your HOOKER HEADER exhaust system.

BEFORE STARTING:

Your vehicle must be raised a minimum of 36 inches. A floor hoist is ideal. If no hoist is available, we strongly urge the use of axle stands as a safety measure. Please read these instructions in their entirety before attempting installation.

CAUTION! WORK ONLY ON A LEVEL SURFACE. USE JACKS /JACK STANDS OF SUFFICIENT CAPACITY TO LIFT AND SUPPORT YOUR VEHICLE. NEVER WORK UNDER A VEHICLE SUPPORTED BY A FLOOR OR BUMPER JACK.

INSTALLATION:

- Disconnect the negative cable from the vehicle battery.
- 2. If necessary, lift the vehicle and secure on jack stands.
- 3. Loosen the band clamp securing the OE muffler section to the OE mid pipe.
- 4. Remove the OE exhaust off all rubber isolators and remove OE exhaust.
- 5. Loosen the u bolt clamp at the front of OE mid pipe, and remove OE mid pipe.
- 6. Install Driver's side tail pipe hanger bracket onto the end of 2 existing hitch/frame bolts with the (x2) supplied 14mm nuts, and tighten nuts at this time. Then slide (x1) supplied rubber isolator onto hanger rod.
- 7. Using (x1) supplied 3.0" band clamp, install the Blackheart Mid Pipe over OE Y-pipe and onto rubber isolator. Do not tighten the band clamp.
- 8. Using (x1) supplied 3.0" band clamp, install the BlackHeart Muffler Inlet Pipe over the BlackHeart Mid Pipe and onto the rubber isolator. Do not tighten the band clamp.
- 9. Using (x1) supplied 3.0" band clamp, install the Blackheart Muffler section over the inlet pipe and onto the rubber isolators on the chassis. Do not tighten the band clamp.
- 10. Using (x2) supplied 2.5" band clamps, install the BlackHeart Over-Axle Pipes onto the muffler section, but do not tighten the band clamps.
- 11. Using (x2) supplied 2.5" band clamps, install the BlackHeart Tailpipes onto the rubber isolators and then over the over-axle pipes. Do not tighten the band clamps.
- 12. Align the BlackHeart Exhaust System and tighten all band clamps.
- 13. Connect the battery, start the engine, and check for leaks.
- 14. Re-check your work.
- 15. Remove the jack stands and lower the vehicle.
- 16. After 150 miles, re-check and tighten all bolts.

NOTE: It is normal for the BlackHeart Headers to emit smoke for the first few minutes during break-in period.
