## PLEASE READ BEFORE PROCEEDING

PerTronix<sup>©</sup> thanks you for choosing a JBA Performance Exhaust Product. To realize the potential of JBA's engineering and excellent fit, Please Read and Understand these instructions completely prior to starting the installation.

Check that you received all the parts listed on the parts list, if you have any concerns, please contact PerTronix before continuing.

Work Smart – Work Safe! Most Exhaust Installations are best performed on a lift. If a lift is not available, raise the vehicle and support on quality Jack Stands on level ground. Do not rely on a jack!

Before starting, allow the vehicle to cool, disconnect the battery, and spray penetrating oil on all hardware and fittings that will need to be removed. Silicone spray on rubber hangers will make them easier to remove and install.

- 1. Cut the tail pipe just behind the muffler with a Sawzall or hack saw.
- 2. Undo the clamp for the muffler from the head pipe.
- 3. Install the new intermediate pipe using the 2 1/4" clamp. Slip a 2 1/2" U-bolt clamp over the centered end of the muffler and position the JBA muffler onto the intermediate pipe. The offset, outlet of the muffler goes towards the driveshaft side.
- 4. Place the U-Bolt clamp over the muffler outlet. Slip the over axle pipe in place and into the muffler. Slip the hanger in to the original hanger at the back of the JEEP.
- 5. Slip the Stainless Tip and T-Bolt Clamp over the end of the over axle pipe outlet.
- 6. Align the system so that it is in the proper place, the muffler should be parallel with the ground. When satisfied with the alignment, Tighten all of the clamps
- 7. Reconnect the battery and Start the vehicle, checking for leaks, tighten as needed. Recheck all clamps after 100 Miles. We recommend tack welding all joints to insure they don't come loose out on the trail.
