## **REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION:**

- 1. Remove air filter housing cover.
- 2. Remove air filter from air filter housing.
- 3. Inspect the air filter housing and ensure that both the air filter housing and engine air inlet are clean. Wipe away any dirt or contaminates from these surfaces as well as the air filter housing.
- 4. Inspect the dirty air filter for any signs of leakage or damage.
- 5. Install the K&N $^{\circ}$  air filter, making sure the air filter seats completely.
- 6. Replace gasket with supplied K&N® gasket (Fig. 1 & 2).
- 7. Replace the air filter housing cover, ensuring the housing cover is attached securely.
- 8. Reset vehicle air filter restriction gauge.
- 9. Service air filter at 15"H2O or once a year.
