K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

- 1. Locate cabin air filter access panel under the hood on passenger side of the firewall and unfasten access panel to reveal cabin air filter. Fig. 1 & 2
- 2. To remove cabin filter, push and hold lever on the left side of filter while removing air filter. Fig. 3
- 3. Remove cabin air filter. Note: Remove any dirt and debris that might be present in cabin filter tray and housing. NOTE: K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filter has cut outs that will allow the filter to bend into the correct shape for proper fitment. Fig. 4
- 4. Install K&N® cabin air filter into housing. Slide filter into frame aprox 1/3 the way in. Fig. 5

  NOTE: Ensure the filter is installed with the cut outs facing up, and the directional arrow facing towards the firewall of the vehicle. Fig. 4
- 5. Bend filter to wrap underneath into smaller portion of frame and slide cabin air filter into frame. Fig. 6 & 7
- 6. Reinstall cabin filter access panel. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area on the housing and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a re-usable cabin filter.
