# TUBING KIT INSTALLATION (Figure 1):

- 1. Assemble nylon tube and fittings as shown.
- Route nylon tube to gauge clear of moving or hot engine components. Protect nylon tube from sharp edges through firewall using a rubber grommet.

**NOTE:** When being used with vacuum gauge you may choose to connect to a vehicle vacuum line. In this case, a proper "T" fitting should be selected with two barb fittings properly sized for the vacuum line used and a 1/8 NPTF for the tube kit to connect to

**CAUTION:** Nylon tubing is not recommended for use with fuel pressure gauges. Use metal or braided fuel lines.
