


Minimum environmental temperature 65 degrees. Use Acetone to fully


remove all oil and dust. Repeat this process as many as 10 times or more until dirt and oils are no longer picked up.




Gently clean back of decal(s) with acetone.




Note: Applying three to four letters at a time is recommended to ensure adequate time and pressure can be applied in Step 4.





Repeat steps 3-4 for all decals.



Once all the edges are sealed allow decals to sit for a minimum of 1 hour before driving or washing.















Cleaning:

We do not reccomend the use of tire shine products. If Tire Stickers are exposed to tire shine, immediately clean tire shine from surface. Decals can be cleaned using Tire Stickers Cleaning Solution available on our website.

Repair:

If decals begin to show signs of peeling due to application problems, difficult sidewall surfaces or damage from abrasion, repeat application steps #3-4. Additional FleXement Adhesive may be purchased for repairs at www.TireStickers.com. DO NOT USE SUPER GLUE OR SUBSTITUTES.

Removal:

- 1. For each decal, peel up an edge and clamp with pliers.
- 2. Once removed, clean up the remaining adhesive with acetone and a light sanding pad (220 grit).
