


1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.






2. Attach mounting brackets as shown. See Figures 1 and 2.






- 2. Insert square head bolts as shown (3 per slot, 6 per board). See **Figure 3**.
- 3. Attach board to brackets as shown. Make sure board and brackets are properly aligned and tighten fasteners to 15-17 ft-lbs. See **Figure 4**.


