Installation Instructions for 57020 & 57021 LT1 Inlet Elbow

Removal of the stock inlet elbow:

- 1. Disconnect the negative cable at the battery.
- 2. Unplug the air inlet temperature sensor and remove the sensor from the inlet elbow.
- 3. Remove the inlet elbow/resonator assembly. On 1995-1997 models only, the 5/32" hose must be removed from the inlet elbow.

Preparing your new LT1 Inlet Elbow for installation:

- 1. **On Camaro SS Models:** Remove 1" from the round end of the air inlet duct for proper clearance with the mass air flow meter. See illustration below. **NOTE:** Make sure to wrap the inlet elbow with good masking tap before marking or cutting to protect the finish.
- 2. **On 1995-1997 Models:** Drill a hole in the desired location in the bottom of the inlet elbow using a 23/64" drill bit and install the supplied small grommet.
- 3. Install the supplied 1/2" grommet in the side of the inlet elbow for the air inlet temperature sensor.

Installing your new LT1 Inlet elbow on the vehicle:

- 1. Place the large sleeve connector onto the throttle body and secure with a clamp.
- 2. Place the small sleeve connector onto the mass air flow meter and secure with a clamp.
- 3. Install the inlet elbow onto the throttle body while also aligning the inlet elbow with the mass air flow meter.
- 4. Secure the inlet elbow with clamps and tighten to insure that there are no air leaks.
- 5. **On 1995-1997 Models:** Install the 5/32" hose that was removed with the stock inlet elbow in the bottom of your new inlet elbow.
- 6. Install the air inlet temperature sensor into the side of the inlet elbow and reconnect sensor harness.
- 7. Reconnect battery terminal.
