Installation Instructions for 61530 to 61535 Shift Knob with Button

Installation Instructions:

- 1. Screw jamb nut onto the shifter stick so that there is a 1/2" of thread from the top of the stick to the top of the nut.
- 2. Screw the desired threaded insert onto the shifter stick so that the top of the threaded insert is flush with the top of the shifter stick.
- 3. Place a small drop of Loctite on the threaded insert and screw the shifter knob over the threaded insert until it bottoms out on the jamb nut. Let stand for 1 hour so that the Loctite can cure.
- 4. Adjust the jamb nut to the desired height so that the shifter knob is in the desired location. This should be achieved by adjusting the jamb nut up/down on the shifter stick.
- 5. Firmly hold the shifter knob with one hand and turn counter clockwise to tighten the jamb nut against the shifter knob.

Wiring:

The button is a 12 volt N.O. (normally open) switch with two 16 GA. wire leads. The button is bi-directional, meaning either wire can be the 12 volt source.

- 1. Run one wire to a 12 volt power source.
- 2. Run the other wire to the activation wire on your: Trans Brake, Roll Control, Purge Valve or other 12 volt controlled device.
