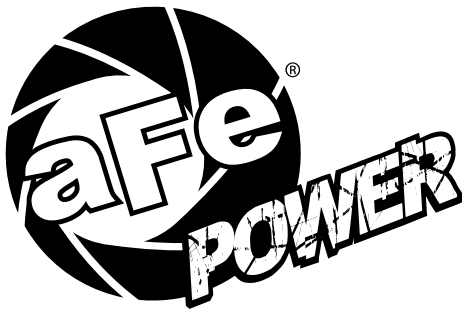

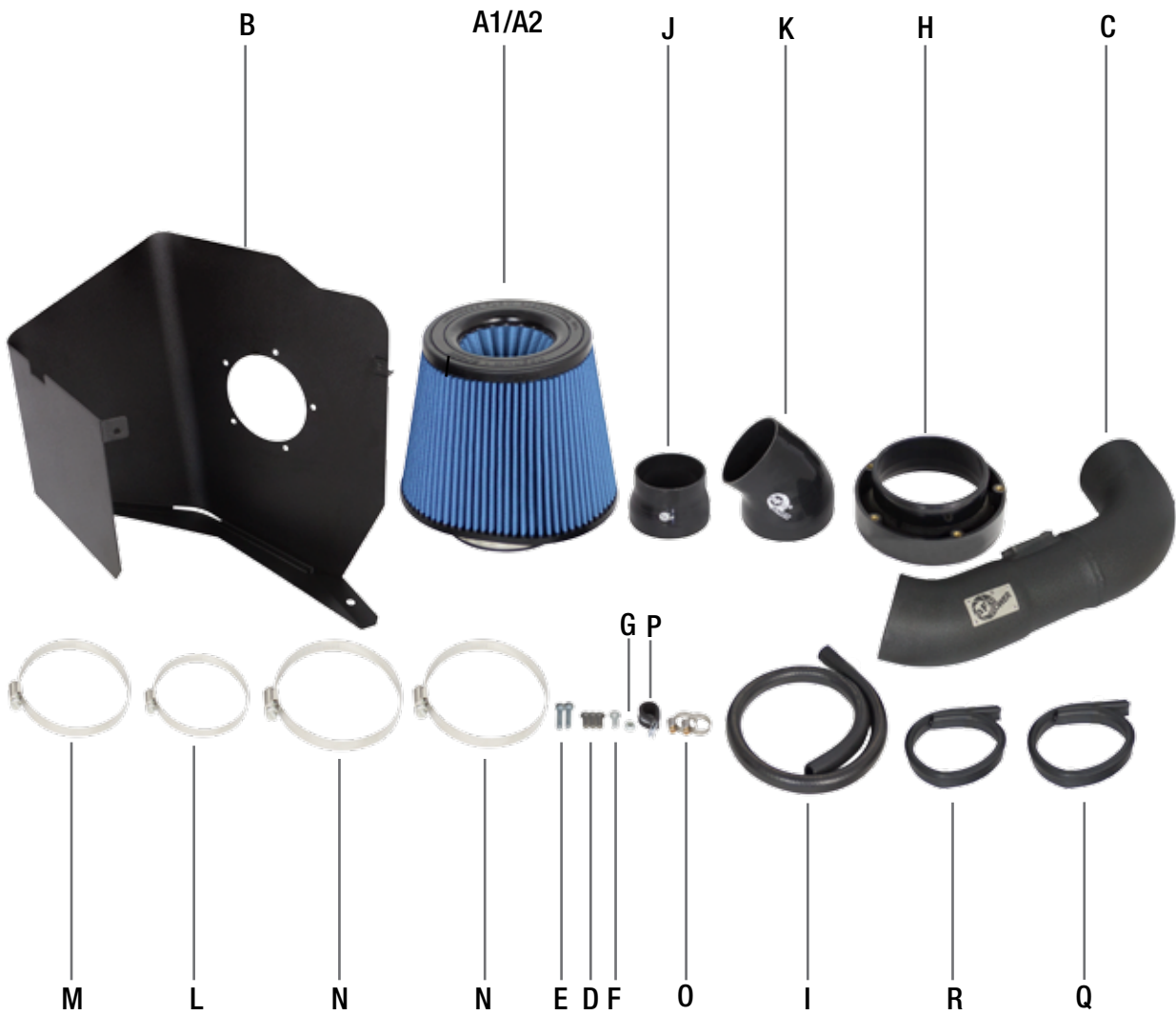




Figure A

Refer to Figure A for Steps 1-4.

Step 1: Disconnect MAF sensor connector.

Step 2: Disconnect crank case breather hose from engine.

Step 3: Remove two T30 torx screws, from front and passenger side of engine cover.

Step 4: Loosen two 8mm bolts from back of engine cover.

Refer to Figure B for Steps 5-7.

Step 5: Loosen two screw clamps (8mm) from engine cover to airbox and throttle body.

Step 6: Remove oil cap.

Step 7: Remove engine cover.



Refer to Figure C for Steps 8-9.

Step 8: Remove two 10mm nuts from airbox. Save for later use.

Step 9: Remove two T20 torx screws from MAF sensor.

Step 10: Install MAF sensor on aFe intake tube using the two supplied M4 screws.

Step 11: Install filter adaptor on aFe air filter housing using the five supplied button head hex screws.

Step 12: Install upper and lower trim seal onto aFe air filter housing.

Step 13: Remove the 10mm nut from front of coolant reservoir. Save for later use.

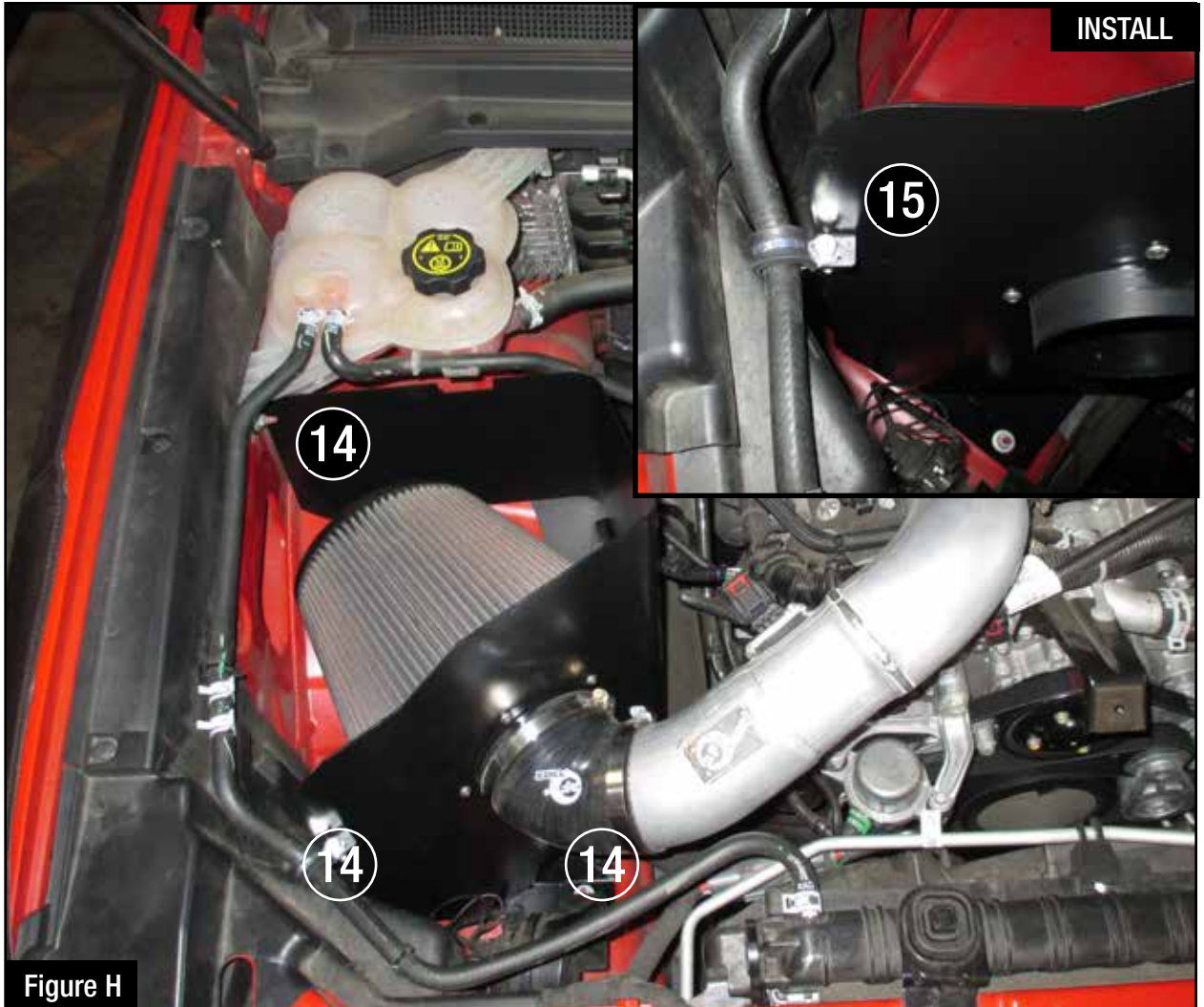

Step 14: Install aFe housing in vehicle using the three factory 10mm nuts.

Step 15: Install fixing clamp to housing and secure coolant hose with 10mm nut and screw.

Step 16: Install coupler onto throttle body using the supplied #48 and #52 screw clamps. (Do Not Tighten at this time)

Step 17: Install aFe elbow coupler onto filter adaptor on air filter housing using the supplied # 52 and # 64 screw clamps. (Do Not Tighten at this time)

Refer to Figure K for Steps 18-21.

Step 18: Install aFe intake tube. Adjust intake tube and tighten all screw clamps.

Step 19: Install new breather hose using supplied mini screw clamps and tighten screw clamps.

Hose can be trimmed if needed.

Step 20: Install air filter and tighten screw clamps.

Step 21: Reconnect Mass Air Flow Sensor harness. Your installation is now complete.

NOTE: Check all bolts, clamps and connectors after 200 miles.

Warranty

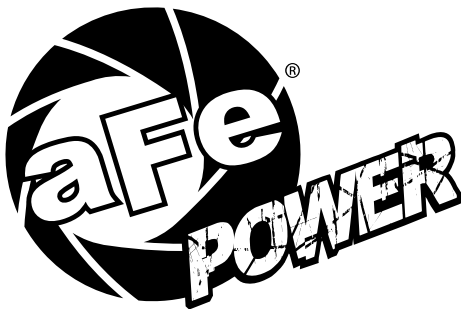
General Terms:
