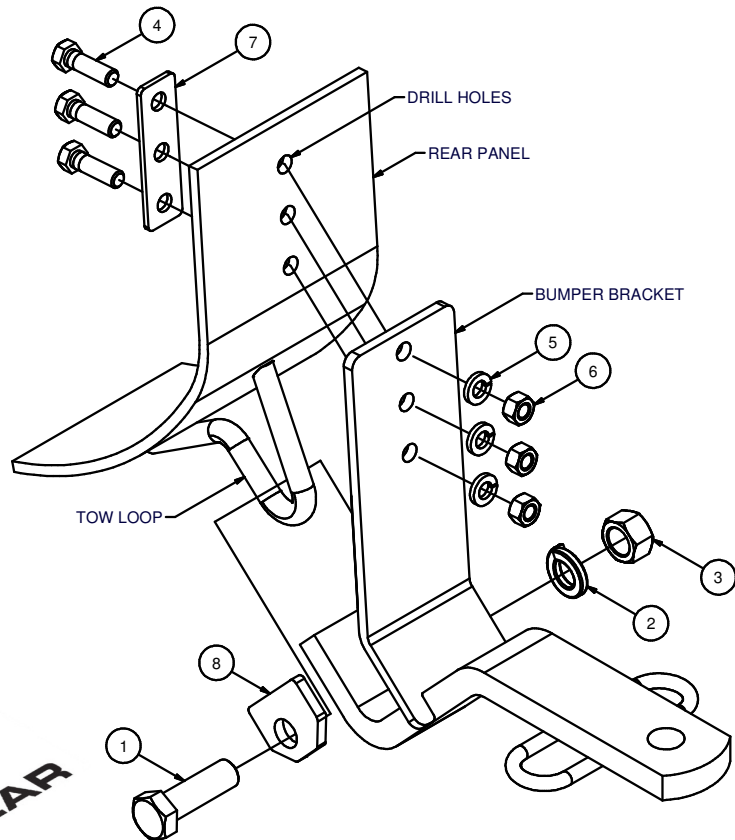

INSTALLATION STEPS

1. Remove the rear bumper from the vehicle to install the hitch.
 - Remove the screws fastening the mud flaps to the bumper fascia at the rear edge of rear tire well. Flap does not have to be removed from tire well.
 - Remove the plastic cover over two bumper screws on each side of vehicle from under the vehicle and rear bumper. Then remove the two bumper screws.
 - Locate and remove one bumper screw from each side under plastic cover inside the rear of cargo area.
 - Remove the rear bumper.
2. Place hitch under tow loop until hitch is flush with tow loop and bumper bracket on hitch is flush and straight with the vehicle's rear panel. Use CM-11592-SP and 5/8" fasteners to sandwich tow loop against hitch.
3. Use hitch's bumper bracket as a template for drilling rear panel for fasteners. Check the hitch position on the vehicle so these holes will be centered on 1" wide recess inside the rear panel. Drill through the rear panel for 3/8" diameter bolts.
4. Fasten hitch to rear panel using 3/8" fasteners with CM-11592-BP inside the rear panel as shown.
5. Torque all 3/8" fasteners to 45 lb-ft, and all 5/8" fasteners to 210 lb-ft.
6. Reinstall rear bumper in the reverse order of directions from Step 1.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
