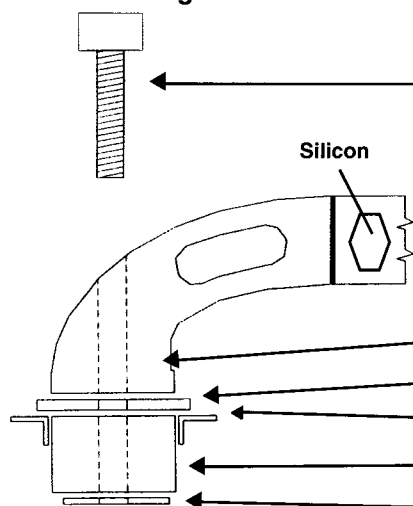

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR STAINLESS STEEL AND BLACK PAINTED SIDE RAILS (A) WITH STAKE POCKETS, (B) WITHOUT STAKE POCKETS, OR (C) WITH TOOLBOX.

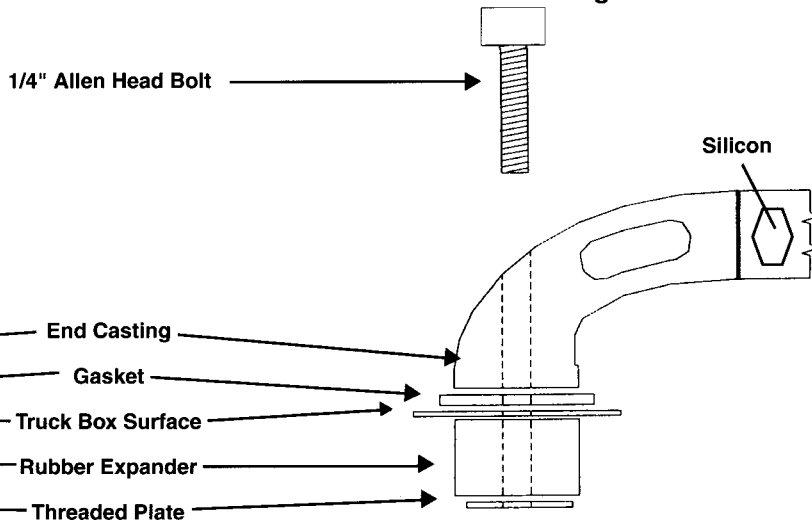
PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION AND BE SURE TO CHECK TO SEE THAT ALL PARTS AND HARDWARE ARE INCLUDED.

NOTE: ON PICKUPS WITH PLASTIC STAKE HOLE INSERTS: REMOVE THE INSERT AND DRILL A 3/8" HOLE IN THE CENTER OF IT. WHEN INSTALLING, PLACE THE FACTORY INSERT BETWEEN THE PUTCO GASKET AND THE RUBBER EXPANDER.

**(A) For Mounting to Sidebed

NOTE: For pickups that do not have stake pocket holes or are mounting with a toolbox, 5/16" holes will need to be drilled for installation of side rails. Apply a silicon sealant to all drilled holes before mounting to prevent any corrosion. Apply a silicon sealant on the inside of the tube where it meets the casting to eliminate any spinning that might occur.

Step 1: Install allen head bolts through the hole in stake pocket casting, rubber oval gasket and rubber expander.

NOTE: Mounting with toolbox: Install casting in rear stake holes. Position other casting on top of bed, mark location to be drilled. Drill a 5/16" hole. Use a flange nut to secure. **(SEE FIGURE (C))**
Due to the strength of the bed on the 1999 Chevy/GMC Silverado, PUTCO recommends using a bed rail protector between the Locker Rail and the truck bed. Failure to do so could cause the truck bed to deform when you tighten the bolt on the front casting.

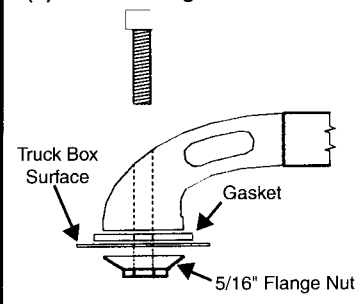
Step 2: Install threaded back plate on the allen head bolt. Snugly tighten using 1/4" allen wrench.

Step 3: Install complete stake pocket assembly into the rear stake hole of the pickup bed.

Step 4: Slide end of tubing over end of stake pocket casting. Repeat step 3 for the front stake pocket hole. **(Be careful not to scratch pickup.)**

Step 5: Tighten allen head bolts using 1/4" allen wrench to 20ft/lbs. for stake pocket mount and 5ft/lbs. for drill mounts.

Note: PUTCO recommends applying a high quality automotive wax to maintain the original appearance, help prevent water spotting and weathering on your new locker side rails.
