



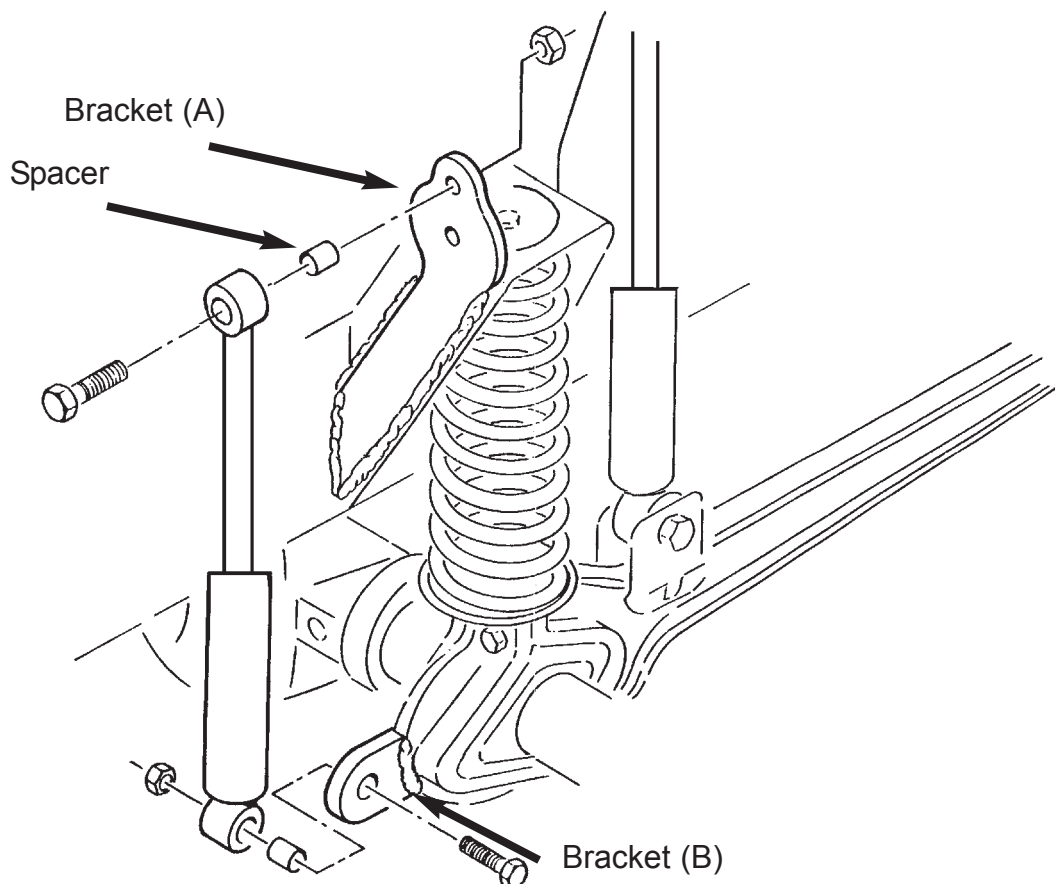
Installation Instructions 1978-1979 Ford Bronco Front Dual Shock Kit Part# DS270

Note: From the factory, all 78-79 Bronco's have a long shock on the Driver Side, in the front of the coil spring, and use a shorter shock on the passenger side behind the coil spring. This is known as "staggered" shocks. Therefore, the additional shocks needed for this installation require that one shock is shorter than the other. When mounting the dual shocks to the brackets, you will need to stagger the shocks on the opposite sides of the stock shocks, using the shorter shock for drivers side and vice versa.

Installation Instruction:

1. Park the vehicle on level ground. Set the emergency brake and block the rear tires.
2. Raise the front driver side of the vehicle and remove the tire. The illustration below is the view of the driver side. On driver side, place upper bracket against coil spring tower as shown being sure to weld entire length of seam between spring tower and bracket.
3. Loosely install bottom bracket (B) to lower shock eye (longer shock) and extend shock. Mark the position for the lower bracket on the ridge of the radius arm bracket.
4. Now remove lower bracket from the shock and weld on at the marked position. NOTE: BE SURE NOT TO MELT THE AXLE BUSHINGS THAT ARE LOCATED ON THE RADIUS ARM. WATER MAY BE NEEDED TO COOL THE AREA. Be sure to paint all areas that were welded to avoid rusting.
5. Mount shock to lower bracket. Note: There are two holes located in the upper bracket (A). Depending on amount of lift and the shock travel you may need will depict which hole is used.
6. Passenger Side: Install bracket (A) to the frame as the stock bracket is mounted to the frame on the Driver Side and weld. Position bracket (B) on top of the radius arm as located on the Driver Side and weld. Install shock.
7. Once all shocks are installed, check all components for proper clearance. Retorque all hardware after the first 100 miles and periodically there after.
